

## **VAT Royal Decree Published**

His Majesty, Sultan Haitham Bin Tariq, approved Royal Decree No.121/2020 on 12 October 2020 for introducing much awaited Value Added Tax ('VAT') in Oman. The said Royal Decree is published in Official Gazette today i.e. 18 October 2020, which effectively means that VAT shall go live either on 16 April 2021 or 17 April 2021 subject to confirmation from Oman Tax Authority.
